The City of McPherson will hold a public hearing on Monday, March 22<sup>nd</sup> 2021 at 8:45 AM, at McPherson City Hall, 400 E. Kansas Avenue McPherson, KS 67460 for the purpose of evaluating the performance of the \$220,000.00 CDBG Grant No. 19-PF-006 which proposed the widening of South chestnut Street from a 26'width to 32' mill and overlay, addition of a new drainage pipe and storm inlets to correct drainage issues and sidewalks along the east side of Chestnut. This \$799,905.07 project was funded, in part, with funds from the Kansas Department of Commerce, Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program.
