


WEAR AND CARE CLOTH FACEMASK



PUT IT ON

Put it over your nose, mouth, and secure it under your chin.

Put on your mask by touching only the tie strings or the elastic. If you're able, touch the front of your mask as little as possible.



TAKING OFF YOUR MASK

Untie or stretch the elastic, and to the best of your ability only touch those two areas.

Fold outside corners together, Place covering in the washing machine, and wash your hands immediately after removing.




WASH YOUR HANDS

Clean hands for a clean mask.

Wash your hands before putting on your face covering.

- 1 Wash hands with water.
- 2 Apply enough soap to cover all hand surfaces.
- 3 Rub hands together covering all surfaces and creating a lather around all hands for at least 20 seconds
- 4 Rinse hands thoroughly and dry completely with clean cloth or towel.



FIT IT SNUGLY

Try to fit it snugly against the sides of your face.

Fitting your mask correctly makes a difference in the amount of times you adjust it throughout the time you are wearing it.



WASHING YOUR MASK

Washing Machine

- You can include your face covering with your regular laundry.
- Use regular laundry detergent and the warmest appropriate water setting for the material.

Washing by Hand

- Mix 5 Tbls (1/3 cup) household bleach per gallon of room temperature water, or
 - mix 4 teaspoons household bleach per quart of room temperature water.
- Check the label to see if your bleach is intended for disinfection. Some bleach products, such as those designed for safe use on colored clothing, may not be suitable for disinfection. Ensure the bleach product is not past its expiration date.
- Soak the face covering in the bleach solution for 5 minutes.
- Rinse thoroughly with cool or room temperature water.
